Your correspondence, directed to the Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of the Inspector General (OIG), was referred to the Initial Processing Unit (IPU), Internal Investigations Section (IIS), Inspection Division (INSD), Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI). The IIS/INSD is the FBI entity responsible for investigating allegations of misconduct or criminal activity on the part of FBI employees.

You reported you are the victim of public corruption by federal judges who handled your civil case, "Tuvell vs. IBM". In addition, you reported the DOJ and the FBI have not provided you assistance.

The purpose of this letter is to advise your information was reviewed and this matter does not warrant the opening of an FBI inquiry. However, your information was forwarded to the FBI's Criminal Investigative Division, Public Corruption and Civil Rights Section, for appropriate attention. IPU will take no further action.
