- §11: «matter» → «matters»
- §11: «i.e.» → «I.e.»
- §11: boldface the entire [a](i) paragraph
- §13: «ft§v» → «§vf†»
- §11f24: add: «STRICT LIABILITY. Some rules are meant to be NEVER broken.»

1 • None of the changes affects the Petition at a material level. They're all just trivial/perfectionistic tweaks/typos, for the purpose of presenting the best possible "product" to the Committee, with the sole ultimate goal of catalyzing ultimate Justice.

- ¶15 top: remove extraneous «)»
- ¶18, Montaigne quote: «so» → «also»
- ¶18, Montaigne quote: «“merely» → «merely»
- ¶18, Montaigne quote: transpose «before» and the bracketed comment
- ¶19, end of second paragraph: add ref to [a](i)
- ¶19: «“standard”» → «illogic/“standard”»
- ¶20: «bonkers» → «bonkers/cynical»
