 - tissue samples "consistent with" death by asbestosis
 - Celotex response no affidavit contradicts

- Substance of Affidavits
 - What is sufficient to show GIMF?
 - Letter from supervisor
 - "I can testify that at time w/in s/lMr. C was exposed to Celotex asbestos in D.C"
 - Letter from supervisor
 - "I can tell you which asbestos we used in the factory when Mr. C. worked there"

 - Letter from supervisor proper evidence?
