We wrote to you because we had not yet filed in federal court, and because we needed help writing an appropriate Complaint. So for the moment we cannot take advantage of your referral.

We write now to ask you to put us on the TOP of your list when you start to actually help *pro se* litigants. And if you think of private attorneys who might want to take the case on a contingency or pro bono basis, please let us know.

Thanks for getting in touch. I have just begun this position as the public services attorney at the law library and our plans do not include taking on providing limited legal assistance for at least the first six months. However, I do know that the United States District Court for the Western District of Washington has a pro bono panel of attorneys who take on cases for free. You can apply for their assistance starting on this webpage:

Dear Mr. Lampson:

We understand you have been hired by the Law Library of King County to assist *pro se* litigants.

We are a married couple, senior citizens who live in King County. For a number of years we represented ourselves *pro se* in matters before the Superior Court in Seattle.

During the proceedings, we were stripped of \$842,734.67 without due process of law, in violation of our Fifth and Fourteenth Amendment rights of the US Constitution. The violation of our rights occurred with the approval of the appeals courts of Washington.

The attached print-out of our webpage, Everyones-Business.org, describes the circumstances. Full documentation, including court pleadings, is available to you at the website.

We want to go into Federal District Court to rectify the situation. We request your help in preparing our Complaint.

We think our case will be entirely suited to your mission: Clearly we were treated so shamefully at least in part *because we were pro se*. The contempt with which the judges and opposing lawyers treated us was palpable.
