## PETITION FOR REVIEW

Pursuant to JCDR<sup>†</sup> 18(a,b), **I hereby petition the Judicial Council for review** of the Chief Judge's opinion/order (dated Mar 8 2018), herein called "**JCOp**" dismissing the above-captioned Complaint.

As **reason** therefor, I state my strong belief/conviction/knowledge that the JCOp as filed is wholly wrong, and even knowingly/willingly/criminally false. As detailed support for that stated reason, I hereby refer to (and hereby incorporate) the **new Complaint of Judicial Misconduct** (and its accompanying materials), which I am also filing this day, against JCOp's issuing Chief Judge, for the same reason (false JCOp). **All** of the information contained-in (or referred-to, transitively) by that *new* Complaint — including, especially, the website (**<http://JudicialMisconduct.US>**), and its accompanying **Memoir Annotated, "MemAnn"** (*q.v.*) — is hereby adopted/incorporated as information to be applied to the instant Petition, too.

For your convenience, I am including with this Petition a copy of the document "**JCOpAnn**," which is an *annotated version* of JCOp (filed primarily as a support document for the said *new* Complaint).
