

# Filing Notice To SJC

Pursuant to MRAP §27(f) (“Notice to Supreme Judicial Court”), notice is hereby given that a Motion For Reconsideration Or Modification Of Decision has been filed this day by appellant in the case of *Tuvell v. Marshall* (№ 2018-P-1605 in the Appeals Court, № 1781CV02701 in Middlesex Superior Court), via the eFileMA electronic system (also available at <http://JudicialMisconduct.US/sites/default/files/2019-11/MotReconMod.pdf>).

We respectfully suggest that this case is a ripe candidate for review by the SJC, because it involves “substantial matters affecting the public interest and interests of justice:” **In defamation cases, does Massachusetts support the teachings of *Milkovich v. Lorain Journal*, 497 U.S. 1 (1990), or does it ignore the U.S. Supreme Court and continue to support pre-1990 Massachusetts law (as the lower courts have done in this case)?**
