We want to notify you that the law firm of McNaul, Ebel, Nawrot, Helgren may be attempting to secure improper release of monies from the Registry of the Court. These moneys were sent to the Registry by Mark and Carol DeCoursey, pursuant to proceedings in Lane Powell v. Mark & Carol DeCoursey, Case No. 11-2-23496-3 SEA in which the McNaul firm represents Lane Powell. See attached.

Bonnie, thank you for contacting us on this matter.

According to the paperwork you provide, that email from the plaintiff's attorney at McNaul was sent to you on Jan. 31, 2013. But some days prior, on Jan. 28, 2013, McNaul was served with our Notice of Appeal (attached). The bond you hold is our supersedeas bond against that appeal, as another McNaul attorney acknowledges in a letter sent on OUR appeal attorney on February 4 (also attached).
